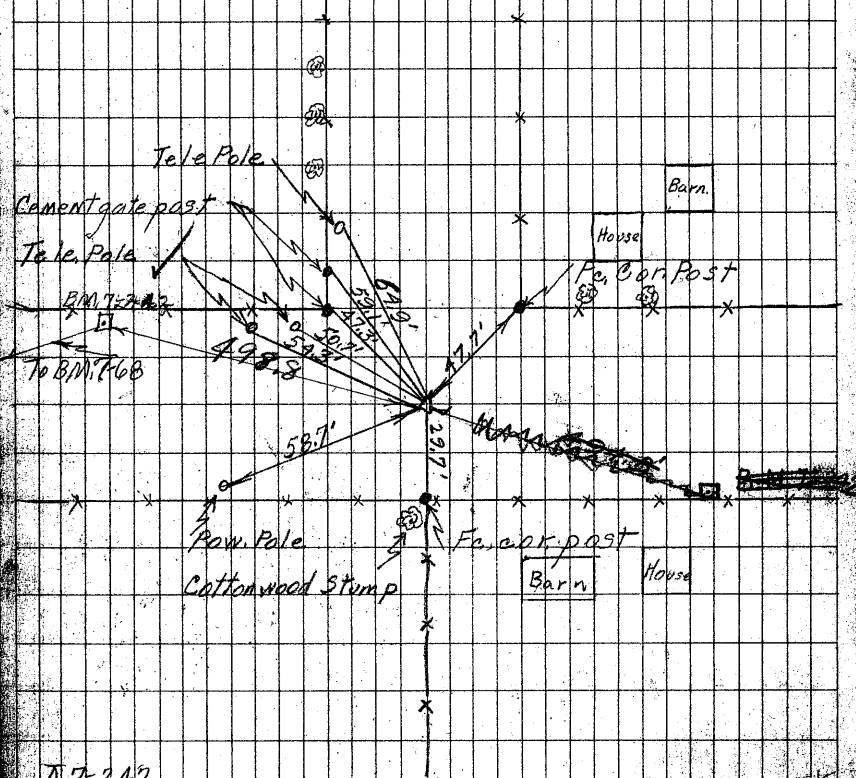
53+150 = N.W. cor sec. 12-30-12 Found 14"x10"x4"
